Conference and meeting facilities



The Rooms

The museum is set in the historic building of a former railway station. The conference facility within the museum is modern and comfortable, ideal for meetings, presentations, seminars, product launches, team building and training events.

Meeting Room

The meeting room contains a digital projector and screen, and can comfortably seat 30 delegates around tables or 50 in rows.

John Baker Hall

The John Baker Hall is a circular room which can accommodate up to 110 people. The room can be set out in any configuration and trade or information exhibitions can be displayed on boards, if appropriate, around the edge of the room. This room is only available between museum exhibition openings which are about 3 - 4 times a year. Please contact the Museum Manager for further details about booking this space.
